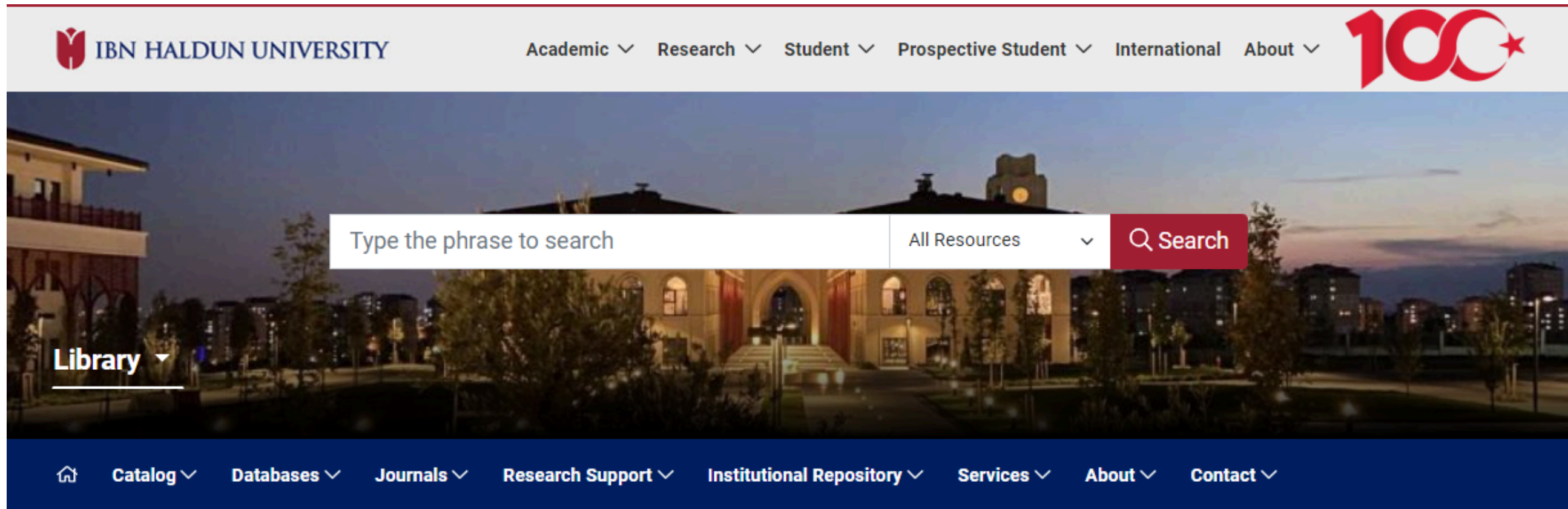




Researcher Profile Creating Guide

The Library subscribes to the databases required by the needs of the users. Databases can be accessed directly at the campus and outside the campus 24/7 via a proxy.



Step 5: Create a ORCID


On your profile page, locate the option labeled 'Create or Connect your ORCID' or similar, and click on it. If you already have an ORCID account, link it to your Web of Science profile. Otherwise, create a new ORCID account

To synchronize your researcher profile with ORCID, follow these steps:

- Log in to your Web of Science account.
- Go to the "Profile Settings" tab (located in the top right corner next to your name).
- Select the "ORCID Syncing" tab.
- Click on the "Connect your ORCID" button to link both profiles.
- Then, log in to your ORCID account.
- Confirm your login details and select the 'Authorize access' button.
- This process will return you to the Web of Science profile settings menu, displaying your linked ORCID identifier - you can change synchronization and permission settings between the profiles.
- Publications imported from ORCID will now be visible on your main Researcher Profile page and the "My publication records" page (denoted by a "+" sign).

Step 6: Define Your Research Areas

Add or update your research areas on your profile. It will assist you in discovering and keeping track of new studies in your areas of interest.


